Local Rules

These Local Rules are applicable in addition to the 'Hard Card' of Swiss Golf and replace all Local Rules previously published by Bonmont Golf & Country Club, particularly those printed on the score cards and in the birdie books.

Out of Bounds (R 18)

They are defined by fences, **wild boar electric fences**, white stakes and/or white lines.

Internal Out of Bounds (LR A-4)

- The white/green stakes between holes n° 9 and 10 and between holes n° 12 et 15 define only the out of bounds limit when playing holes n° 10 and 12. These stakes are treated as boundary objects during the play of holes 10 and 12. For all other holes, they are immovable obstructions.

Abnormal Course Conditions, (including Immovable Obstructions) (R 16.1)

The wild boar electric fences (wires and stakes), **whether or not defining an out of bound limit**: if a player's ball lies on the course and withing a two club-lengths distance of the electric fence, she may, without penalty, take relief under Rule 16.1, using as the reference point the point that is at two club-lengths from the fence and at an equal distance from the hole.

Dropping zones (R 16.1b)

Holes n° 7 (right side behind the green) et 17 (left side of the green): in addition to the options for clearing immovable obstructions (path, barrier).

No play zone (R 16.1f)

- The zone delimited by red stakes with green tops in front of the double green of holes n° **9 et 18** is a **no play zone to be treated as penalty area**. The player **must** take relief with penalty under R 17.1e.
- The flower beds near the tee boxes at holes n° 1 et 10 are defined as **ground under repair**. The player must take relief (R 16.1f).
